INSPECTOR KELEGHAN'S REPORT.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,—

I beg to submit my report, as under, for the period 3rd February to 31st December, 1936, during which as an Inspector of the Society, I did duty in Caernarvonshire.

General Remarks.

I attended as regularly as possible all Horse, Cattle and Poultry Markets, also Railway Cattle Sidings during the loading and unloading of animals.

The following have also been attended: (a) Horse Races; (b) Agricultural and other Shows.

Riding Schools.

Frequent visits have been paid to Riding Schools and every effort made to restrain holiday visitors from urging horses to gallop on hard and unsuitable surfaces.

Horses and Ponies on Sands.

The horses and ponies let out for hire on the seashore at various places in my district have been examined from time to time, and care has been taken that the animals have been fed and watered.

Transit of Animals by Road.

Every effort has been made to enforce the provisions of the Transit of Animals (Amendment) Order of 1931. Any contravention of the Order seen by me has been brought to the notice of the Police.

Humane Slaughtering.

There are still some Local Authorities in my District which have refrained from passing a resolution to include sheep in Section 1 of the Slaughter of Animals Act, 1933. This means that all sheep and lambs in the areas under their control may still be slaughtered by the old method instead of being rendered unconscious by a mechanical instrument before being slaughtered, as provided in the Act. The Authorities concerned have been approached by me personally and by letter from Headquarters.

Hobbling of Sheep.

The practice of hobbling sheep is prevalent in Caernarvonshire, and observation has been kept on such animals to ensure that they receive proper care and attention when so hobbled.

Oil Pollution of Sea.

I regret that I have again to report considerable loss of life and suffering among sea birds as a consequence of oil pollution of the sea. Some of the birds washed in by the tide were still alive when I saw them, but their feathers were so badly contaminated with oil that treatment would have been unavailing, and these were painlessly destroyed.

Painless Destruction of Animals.

I have painlessly destroyed all unwanted ad injured animals brought to me.

There are now lethal chambers at the following places for the destruction of small animals :--

INSPECTOR GIBBONS' REPORT.

To the Hon. Secretary and Committee of the Caernarvonshire and Anglesey Branch of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,—

I beg to submit my report, as under, for the period 17th February to the 31st December, 1936, during which as an Inspector of the Society I did duty in Anglesey.

General Remarks.

I attended as regularly as possible all Horse, Cattle, and Poultry Markets, also Cattle Sidings during the unloading and loading of animals.

The following have also been attended :—Horse Races, Agriculture and other Shows.

Hobbling of Sheep and Goats.

The practice of hobbling sheep and goats is still very prevalent in Anglesey, and five persons have been successfully prosecuted for failing to give such animals proper care and attention when so hobbled.

Importation of Animals from Irish Free State.

I have constantly visited the Lairages and Cattle Boats at Holyhead, and kept observation on the unloading of animals from the boats, and there entrainment at the Cattle Sidings.

Riding Schools.

Frequent visits have been paid to Riding Schools, and every effort made to restrain holiday visitors from urging horses to gallop on the hard and unsuitable surfaces. Ponies have been examined for sores, etc. Care has been taken that horses and ponies let out on hire on the seashore have been fed and watered.

Youthful Drivers.

Particular attention has been given to incompetent boy drivers, and advice given as to the treatment of their horses, etc.

Humane Slaughtering.

I have paid periodical visits to the Slaughter-Houses in the district, and kept observation on the slaughter of animals.

Painless Destruction of Animals.

There are lethal chambers at the following places where small unwanted animals will be put to sleep:—1, Police Station, Holyhead, 2, Mr. Pari Jones, Chemist, Menai Bridge. Several diseased and worn out animals have been destroyed by me, thus terminating their suffering.

REPORT OF HON. SECRETARY AND TREASURER.

MR. PRESIDENT, LADIES AND GENTLEMEN,—

I have pleasure in presenting my report for the past year. The financial results are satisfactory, showing an increase in the subscriptions from a few districts, notably Bangor, due to the energy of the newly appointed Hon. Secretary, Miss Knight Cross. On the other hand, no collections were made at Nevin, Trearddur Bay, Aberdaron, Criccieth, Llanberis, Llanerchymedd, Llanfair P.G., Llanddeusant and Rhosgoch.

The Flag Day at Bangor was most successful. I wish this year again to specially mention, Mrs. Keleghan, who was responsible for quite three parts of the total amount collected. She entertained for this occasion her four young lady assistants from Oswestry, and in other ways Mrs. Keleghan financially is a great help to our Branch.

I again urge Hon. Secretaries to form Junior Leagues in their districts, humane education amongst children being most important. I also ask them to kindly complete their collections in the first month of the year. As the financial year of the Society ends in February, this would greatly assist us, and enable us to arrange for the Annual Meeting to be held earlier than has been usual, and so avoid one year running into another.

Essay competitions have been held at the schools, and books awarded as prizes. Merit badges were given for the best conditioned horses at the Bangor Rose Queen Festival and the Menai Bridge Carnival. Framed certificates and gratuities from Headquarters have been awarded, also books given for the rescue of animals at Abersoch and Bethesda.

“Animal Sunday” was observed at several places. New Secretaries will be required for Nevin, Llanfair P.G., Brynsiencyn, Llann-daniel, Llanfaethlu, Portdinorwic, and Llangefni.

Inspector Keleghan in Caernarvonshire and Inspector Gibbons in Anglesey are doing good work. They are both most excellent officers and most helpful to me in the working of the Branch, and always ready to do any little extra service.

The thanks of the Committee are greatly due to Mr. W. J. Edwards, Bethesda, for kindly auditing the accounts and typing the Balance Sheet.

Finally, I wish to thank our Chairman, Councillor Mrs. Chamberlain, the Auxiliary Secretaries and Collectors for their valuable help, and the members of the Press for their readiness at all times to further the Society's work.

REPORT OF ANNUAL MEETING.

The Annual Meeting was held at St. James' Church Room on July 9th, 1937, at 3 p.m. Councillor W. O. Williams (Deputy Mayor), Tanderwen, presided in the absence of the Right Worshipful the Mavor of Bangor.

In his address, Mr Williams said he was pleased to be associated with a Society doing such good work, and he wished to congratulate the Branch workers on the year's successes. The minutes of the last Annual Meeting were read and adopted.

The Inspectors' Reports were afterwards adopted.

The Reports of Hon. Treasurer and Secretary showed a substantial increase financially, and also in the work of the Branch. These reports were then read and adopted. The General Committee was re-elected, as also was the Executive Committee, with the addition of Miss Megan Evans, Bethesda. Mr. Diggon, Assistant Secretary from Headquarters, then gave a most interesting address, touching upon the problem of the stray dog, the trapping of wild birds, the exportation of horses abroad, the suffering caused to sea birds by oil pollution, the granting of free dog licences, and the great benefit received by the animals of the poor, where free treatment could be given by the Branch, financially able to do so. He also referred to the numbers of stray cats, which amounted to some thousands in the large towns. Whenever possible these were painlessly destroyed. Captain Durham, Regional Organizer, also

addressed the meeting. He maintained how necessary it was to encourage the humane treatment of animals by children; this could be done by having "Pet" Shows and Films shown, and also forming Junior Leagues of the R.S.P.C.A. in different districts.

Presentations were then made of framed Certificates and gratuities for the rescue of animals to the following persons:—Mr. Morris Williams, 7, Cae'rbellan, Bethesda, for the rescue of sheep from drowning; Mr. Edward Davies, 3, Penygraig, Bethesda, for rescuing a dog from drowning; Mr. G. Roberts, Middle Street, Bethesda, for rescuing a dog also from drowning; Mr G. Roberts, Braich Ty Du Farm, Bethesda, for the rescue of a ram from a ledge of rock. A token of appreciation was also given to Mr. J. Thomas, Ogwen Street, Bethesda, for the rescue of a dog from drowning. In addition to these names it was mentioned that a book and token of appreciation had been sent by Headquarters to Master Charles Williams, King's Arms Hotel (aged 14 years), for the rescue of a cat from drowning in the River Ogwen.

A vote of thanks was then accorded the Chairman, Mr. Diggon, Captain Durham, the officials, Auxiliary Secretaries, Collectors, and the Hon. Auditor, Mr. W. J. Edwards, Bethesda. Tea was afterwards served.
